SWISS EXPLOIT stalked the pace from the outside, moved up to take command after going three-quarters, quickly opened a clear lead soon after and maintained that margin in the drive. GENERAL JOE showed no early speed, moved between foes through the back-stretch, reached a striking position into the stretch but could not gain on the winner late. TRIBUTE TO SISSY lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, was bumped nearing the three-sixteenths marker and finished with good energy when clear. WATCH YOUR MONEY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. WEST SEATTLE BOY was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good late energy. LITTLE MORDI raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. SIMPERIO hopped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to rally. CAPELLA ETOILE raced off the leaders throughout and lacked the needed closing response. CASTLE PINES sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. MESHUGUNA was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. DOCTOR PAV raced off the pacesetters from the inside and weakened after going six furlongs. TURNTABLE BAY chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after three-quarters.
