MO'S FLASHY DATE was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. TACTICIAN pressed the pace from off the rail throughout, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. OUR TAIL WIN raced off the pacesetters from the inside, reached a striking position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. FASTNFOXY lacked early speed, moved between rivals nearing the quarter and finished evenly in the drive. DRAMATIC MARINO raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and failed to threaten. BROTHER DAVE raced off the leaders throughout and lacked the needed closing response. EXCESSARIO raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and failed to rally. REGAL FEVER was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor. PERFECT KIVA showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. HOLLOW THE GOLD chased the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. TATANKA lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. MAKE A MOVE BABY pressed the pace from between foes, was pulled up after the opening quarter and vanned off.
