Footnotes

ANY WAGER was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, moved between foes nearing the quarter, angled outside I'M ROUGH N READY nearing the furlong marker and proved best over that rival through the final yards. I'M ROUGH N READY was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead into the lane but could not resist the winner late. BAGSHOTS DAWN was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and finished with good energy. WELFARE CADILLAC was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside and gave way in the drive. DR. DANIEL showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. GILGAL was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. EXCESS TEMPTATIONS was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half.
