HE'S A GOBLIN went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, turned back the bid of HE'S A GOBLIN nearing the three-eighths marker, drifted out into and through the lane and held off that rival in the drive. CHRIS GO broke sharply to chase the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the three-eighths pole, was carried out through the turn and lane and finished with good courage. SMART AS JIM hopped at the start, raced off the rail through the turn and finished with a late rally. SWISS EXPLOIT chased the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. ROMAN ACCOUNT lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. CORRIENDO BAQUERO showed brief speed and weakened.
