Footnotes

DELAWARE DOE broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was all out to hold MR. ICHIBAN off by a diminishing margin. MR. ICHIBAN was never far back, raced wide through the turn, responded to steady urging and was getting to the winner late. TILLMAN'S IMAGE lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the second turn, angled inside and outside into the lane and finished with good courage. MILITARY DEPUTY raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. RAISE THE HEAT showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled outside approaching the stretch and failed to threaten. RANDOM MEMO chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
