OLD MASON was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, opened a clear lead into the lane and held off KENNY PENNY late to prevail. KENNY PENNY lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. OKOBOJI was never far back while racing from off the rail and finished willingly in the drive. BOLD OFFICER raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and finished evenly late. RICH N RARE lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, angled outside nearing the sixteenth pole and did not threaten. INAHURRY showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch and was not a factor. J'S GERRON was away alertly to duel for the lead from between foes and weakened after going a half. REASON TO RECKON raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. HERE COMES LUCKY dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half.
