JAMIN BEN was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead with three-sixteenths to run and was all out to hold DRACON safe late. DRACON was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the inside, responded when set down for the drive and finished with good energy. NEVER BENCHED lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a solid rally. HIGH WATER BAY raced off the leaders throughout and finished evenly in the drive. EX TREMELY COOL pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after five furlongs. MR. FEBRUARY was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. INCLEMENT WEATHER showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. LETS JET was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside, gradually gave way and was eased late.
