Footnotes

SUMBAS ROCKET went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased his margin through the back-stretch, lugged out badly through the final quarter and was ridden out to the wire. SUNDAY SCHOOLIN chased the winner from off the rail throughout and was up late for the place. BIG IVAN raced off the pacesetters throughout and finished with some late run. HIGH ON WINE was away alertly to chase the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. ECLIPSING MOON lacked early speed, raced wide through the first turn, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was carried out by the winner and gave way in the drive. LUCKY TUCKY lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. SLEWS FREEDOM raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and was not a factor. INDY'S GRAND SON showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention.
