Footnotes

ALBIHIGHWAY raced off the leaders early, moved outside though the second turn, gained a slight edge nearing the three-sixteenths pole and held off THE SUPPLY PROGRAM in the drive to prevail. THE SUPPLY PROGRAM raced off the pacesetters early, moved between rivals in mid-stretch but could not get by the winner late. ROMAN ACCOUNT pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a brief lead nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way in the drive. HE'S A BARN RAT showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and finished with some late run. TOM'S RULES lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly late. GRIMACING raced off the leaders throughout and failed to rally. KAFFEINATOR broke in stride to take command at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and weakened after going six furlongs. RAISE THE HEAT was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and was not a factor. PIONEERING PRO showed brief speed and weakened. VALENTOAD weakened after going a half.
