**Footnotes**

TIZ A TREASURE set the pressured pace racing four wide, edged clear leaving the turn, and was ridden out to maintain a safe advantage. D DEVIL vied for the lead racing two wide from between horses, was no match for the winner, but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. QUARTEZ pressed the pace racing between horses from three wide, weakened during the drive, but had enough left to hold the show. OPTIMO broke out and bumped FUTURE GOLD at the start, prompted the pace racing along the inside, but flattened out entering the stretch and faded. FUTURE GOLD was bumped at the start and had his rider lose the outside iron, raced wide thereafter and was never a factor. SHOOT DA MOON contended racing along the inside, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out.
