LES CRIME was bumped at the start, moved up quickly to duel for the early advantage with JIMMIE THE GROUCH, disposed of that rival into the lane, increased his advantage and was kept to task to the wire. LITIN'S HEIR was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. WHATSINTHESOUP was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. COURAGEOUS COMMAND lacked early foot, raced off the rail throughout and finished with some late run. CANT CATCH RICKY G broke out to bump rival, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. JIMMIE THE GROUCH was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after going a half.
