Footnotes

MIOMOUD dueled for the lead from the inside, edged away from DRACON late and held BUCK RUN safe. BUCK RUN raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. BENSON ROAD lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. DRACON dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way late. SMART DECISION was void of early speed, moved between foes through the lane and finished with some late run. PRINCE SMILEY was away alertly to chase the leaders from the inside and gave way after three furlongs. PORTLAND TOWER was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gave way in the drive. ZIG TOWN lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. FINAL TANK steadied at the start, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. SIR H. C. stumbled at the start and unseated his rider.
