MARK OF A PIRATE was away alertly to race just off the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage his stable-mate nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane. HURRYIN HOOSIER broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way to the winner in the drive. TUCANNON lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and was up late for the show. SAINTLY I AIN'T pressed the pace from the outside for six furlongs and gave way. SUMBAS ROCKET was off slow, raced off the leaders throughout, moved outside through the turn and did not menace. GREEK PASSION showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention.
