PARIS ISLAND stalked the pacesetters from the outside, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the quarter and held gamely to the wire. BORN'N BLUE GENES showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and was gaining on the winner late. STORMIN' PETER set a pressured pace from the outside throughout and gave way grudgingly in the drive. MAMOONYA was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. PEPE LE FEU lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and did not threaten. SUPERSECRETDEVICE broke in the air, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. LITTLE MORDI raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. ALBIHIGHWAY pressed the pace from the inside for a mile and weakened.
