Footnotes

MORNING BOBBIE raced a bit wide into the first turn while being void of early speed, split rivals in mid stretch, responded to steady right hand pressure and was up in the final strides. MOSEY PATCH stalked the pace along the outside, assumed command with a quarter to home, opened up a clear advantage with a furlong to go but could not hold off the late rush of the winner. TATTERDEMALION was unhurried early and made a mild late rally between foes. TRISKABOO, forced to steady a bit on the first turn, was allowed to settle in stride, moved up between horses at the nine-sixteenths pole, angled out on the second turn to offer a bid but lacked the needed closing response. RIO'S ROMANCE stalked the pace for a half mile while saving ground and gave way. MIRACLE BELLE was away sharply to open up a clear lead, set the pace while saving ground and tired in the final furlong. SUSPICIOUS MISS pressed the early pace while racing in good position, drifted out entering the stretch and stopped badly.
