GIL was never far back while racing from off the rail, steadied nearing the quarter, angled outside, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and drew clear late. OH WILSON was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge inside the quarter but could not resist the winner in the drive. STARDEMALION was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenth pole and gave way in the drive. GIVAJUNIOR MINT lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to threaten. AGATE PASS was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside and weakened after going a half. EXCITING KID was loose during the post parade, lugged out throughout and did not reach contention.
