DEBI'S KID was hard hustled to duel for the lead from the outside with DUBAI DEBUTANTE, disposed of that rival with a sixteenth to run and quickly drew off. SWEET DEMAND showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was up for the place. PLUM INDY was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished willingly in the drive. DUBAI DEBUTANTE dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. BORTE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and found her best stride late. END GAME was away alertly to chase the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. GLORIOUS GAME raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened.
