Footnotes

KANSPEED was away alertly to chase the pace of TIGER MTN ROAD from the inside, moved up to take command into the lane, turned back the bid of TUCANNON in mid-stretch, drifted out through the final sixteenth and held that rival off by a diminishing margin. TUCANNON raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, moved up to offer a bid nearing the eighth pole, was carried out by the winner nearing the sixteenth pole and was gaining on that rival late. BABY GOTHAM hopped at the start, saved ground through the turn and finished with good energy. LIQUID INTENSITY broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. TIGER MTN ROAD went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened nearing the furlong marker. SUMBAS ROCKET raced off the leaders early, lugged out through the second turn and gave way. MAGNA TIZED lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and did not threaten.
