HE'S A GOBLIN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside with his stable-mate SMART AS JIM, disposed of that rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. SMART AS JIM was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside with the winner throughout but could not match strides for barn bragging rights in the drive. WHATSINTHESOU was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from off the rail and finished willingly. CASCADE GANGSTA lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and did not threaten. MOJOSLEW raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and was not a factor. STATELY PROSPECT showed no early speed, was pulled up nearing the half and vanned off.
