NOBLE JEFF stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the three-eighths marker, opened a clear lead and held off DICEY DEAL in the drive to prevail. DICEY DEAL broke sharply to press the pace from the inside throughout and finished willingly in the drive. D DEVIL lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with a late rally. ETERNAL WIND raced off the leaders from the inside early, angled out in mid-stretch, lacked the needed late response, was unsaddled on the back-stretch and walked off. WORKS LIKA BULLET was never far back while being hustled along, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed late bid. BOLD OFFICER showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. MAZAMA was away alertly to set a pressured pace and weakened after going a half. MR BAQUERO lacked early foot, raced between foes, moved outside through the turn and did not reach contention.
