DEMON WARLOCK broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage nearing the half, gained a slight edge, turned back the bid of CRIMSON DESIGN with a quarter to run, responded to aggressive handling and held gamely to prevail by the narrowest of margins. MY FRIEND DAVE was never far back while racing from the outside, moved up to challenge the winner in mid-stretch, lugged in, had to be corrected and finished with good energy to just miss. CRIMSON DESIGN raced just off the leaders early, moved outside to launch his bid nearing the quarter, could not get by the winner and gave way in the drive. GRAFTON SQUARE dueled for the lead from between foes for five furlongs and gave way. TENDER OFFER (IRE) was well placed just off the leaders from the inside, moved out approaching the stretch and lacked the needed closing response. DO'S BUCKSHOT was taken back soon after the start, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. KNIGHTSBRIDGE ROAD was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after a half. TIMETOKNOWYOU lacked early foot, raced far wide into the stretch and did not reach contention.
