POKER SARAH stalked the early pace, made a slow steady advance from three deep to vie for the lead on the backstretch, then kicked clear at the quarter pole to win ridden out. BOLD DOLLY was allowed to settle, tried a move on the inside nearing the three-eighths pole but was blocked, then came again in a late rally from between horses to pick up the place. WILD SALSA was unhurried early, rallied at the three-eighths pole to menace, then flattened out in late stretch. JANIES BOUTINIERRE rushed up to contention at once, vied for the lead, then flattened out in the stretch. PLEASANT SIS was unhurried early, produced a middle move, but failed to menace. RUTHSEIBEL TO WIN was away alertly, was hooked immediately to vie for the lead, got used up in the second turn, dropped back, and was distanced.
