UTAHN away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage DRACON with a furlong to run and edged clear of that rival in the drive. DRACON set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way grudgingly to the winner through the final yards. AT THE BADA BING broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, could not stay with DRACON in the drive and gradually gave way. COUNTRY RHYTHM lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly. GENERAL JOE was void of early foot, saved ground into the lane and also finished evenly. GILGAL raced far back early, moved outside through the turn and failed to menace. EXCESS TEMPTATIONS raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. L D DUSTY lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten.
