Footnotes

PATRIOTIC PRINCE stalked the leaders from the inside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a widening margin into the lane and held off the closing TOPOFTHEDAY to prevail. TOPOFTHEDAY was void of early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, angled outside nearing the furlong marker and finished with good energy. NOBLE JEFF was never far back, saved ground throughout and finished willingly in the drive. JIMMIE THE GROUCH was away alertly to set a pressured pace, gave way to the winner after going a half, was unsaddled on the back-stretch and vanned off. COTATI broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. CASTLE PINES showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to reach contention. MOONLIT MASTER was void of early foot, saved ground into the stretch and was not a factor.
