D DEVIL was in the second flight early from between horses, angled out four wide entering the stretch, seized command in mid-stretch and maintained a safe advantage to the finish. SIMPLY GOLDEN pressed the issue early from the inside, could not match strides with the winner in the final furlong but held on fairly well for the place. OLD SPRING allowed to settle early, loomed up boldly from six deep near the quarter pole to launch his bid, but hung slightly in the final eighth and had to settle for a minor award. B'S LIL CHAMP was close up early from the inside, had no late punch. REALLY UNIQUE set a pressured early pace while racing off the rail and weakened late. ANITA CHAMP stalked the early pace from four wide but faltered in the stretch. SCOUT FOR GOLD trailed early, lost contact with his field and was eased to the wire.
