Footnotes

TALK NATIVE stalked the pace from six wide, rallied passing the half mile pole to close willingly, then drew off as the rider pleased to win handily. GOLD FOR THE ROAD was away alertly to set the clear pace, got collared in the turn and proved no match for TALK NATIVE, but was clearly second best. TATTERDEMALION stalked the pacesetter from five wide, only offering a mild rally in the stretch. CALICO KATE stalked the pace and produced a mild rally down the stretch. PRIME CRYSTAL broke slowly, was boxed on the backstretch, swung wide nearing the quarter pole, and made a non threatening mild rally. HAPPY PIRATE stalked the pace from three wide, then flattened out at the quarter pole. CUT FLOWERS was shuffled back early, and put out a dull effort. MAE BE SLEW stalked the pace until tiring with a furlong to go. SO UP TO DATE was hustled along to stalk the pace on the inside, but tired passing the three-eighths pole. MY M SIXTEEN had no speed, and trailed throughout.
