**Footnotes**

LITTLE MORDI was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, responded to steady urging and wore down STREET TITAN in the closing yards. STREET TITAN was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear margin into the lane but could not resist the winner late. RED SEA raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. BIG DAVE L showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. BUCKLE was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. PERFECT KIVA lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and was eased through the lane.
