TENSE BET stalked the early leader, responded when asked, and drew off. SPICY FORMULA was away alertly, to set the pace, but was second best. CABALLITO DE MAR settled outside mid pack, made a late outside rally. ONLY BE CAUSE was mid pack early, and urged to contention in turn, then flattened but still pasted tiring foe. SMART AS JIM raced inside mid pack, stayed inside to press the pace, and gave way. LOBOS ROAR dropped back, made a inside mild late rally. REASON TO RECKON was hustled to press the pace, and gave way. OUTSIDE SHOT trailed outside, no threat.
