### Footnotes

CARSONSCIONE veered out at the start,was forwardly placed outside,drifted out mid turn and still got up to hang on. SONAR EXPRESS broke in,was placed mid pack,and closed with a strong late bid to just miss. DOR L'DOR chased the leaders,took command at the head of the lane,and was out finished. T C'S LILCICSOCITY path was taken out of the gate, dropped back,and had a mild bid. SIP A REE was away a step slow,trailed on the inside, moved farthest outside for a mild bid. DARTOGA DIAMOND hopped at the start, settled back,and finished evenly. MINT CITY had the early lead,went wrong and was eased, and vanned off.
