Footnotes

FORMULA ONE GOLD broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear lead into the lane and held sway to the wire. PRINCE NOVETTI was never far back, raced wide through the turn, angled out further nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. STROLL FOR US raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. WHO'S LAUGHING chased the leaders from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. NOW ALL LIGHTS was away alertly to dispute the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. LOOKIN AT GOLD lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. WORKS FOR SILVER raced off the pacesetters from between rivals and failed to rally. MURRAY THE COP was pinched back at the start, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane and did not threaten. DELAVEGA broke in the air, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. STOMPEM' STANLEY showed brief speed from between foes and weakened. CARSONSCIONE raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. WOODSHED ROMANCE was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
