**Footnotes**

SPOOL GIRL sprinted clear soon after the start, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased her margin into the lane and was ridden out to be kept to task. JANUARY'S LADY raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive but was clearly second best. LADY FRANGELICA chased the winner from the outside and gradually weakened. CAUSE UR A TEN chased the winner from the outside dropped back nearing the five-sixteenths pole and did not menace thereafter. EARLY HABIT was bumped at the break, raced off the pacesetters from the inside and failed to menace. MISS SEAMLESS was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not offer a bid. CHURCHBELLSRINGING showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
