MURPHY CREEK broke in stride to take command at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was ridden out to the wire. MIKADO SILVER drifted out early, chased the winner from the outside throughout, was no match for that rival in the drive but held on well to save the place. COMPETITIVE SPORT raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SONAR EXPRESS was never far back, angled outside nearing the quarter and finished evenly in the drive. POINT DANGER raced off the pacesetters throughout and lacked the needed rally. TAXIT was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. SWEET LOUISE lagged far back throughout.
