Footnotes

SING AND SWING (GB) raced off the leaders early, responded to steady encouragement and wore down SOLAR BOOTS through the final yards to be going away late. SOLAR BOOTS sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, maintained a safe margin into deep stretch but could not match strides with the winner late. CAT VON DIVA broke inward, lacked early speed, raced extremely wide through the turn, moved up for a contending position into the lane but failed to gain on the leaders late. MISS SALOME chased the leaders from the far outside, bumped with EARLY HABIT nearing the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed late response. WAITNONAWOMAN raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and failed to threaten. EARLY HABIT broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside bumped with MISS SALOME into the lane while retreating and continued to give way. SHADES OF BLUE was void of early foot, saved ground into the stretch and was not a factor. FAIR TECHNOLOGY showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not offer a bid.
