Footnotes

LAST EQUITY was off slow then allowed to settle, moved between rivals into the lane, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. SALSA BOY raced off the leaders from the inside into the lane and finished willingly to gain the place. PRINCE NOVETTI was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, offered a bid in tandem with the winner nearing the eighth pole and could not match strides with that rival in the drive. WESTERN WHO was off slow, lagged early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out into the lane and finished with a solid late bid. LITTLEMAN JOHN raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the second turn and failed to rally. NOW ALL LIGHTS set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after going three-quarters. BUH BUH BONES was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. WORKS FOR SILVER broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going six furlongs. CARSONSCLONE was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after a half. SLEWMUNDI raced off the pacesetters from the inside, weakened and was eased through the lane.
