Footnotes

BONES ZEE was away in good order to duel for the lead from the outside with U O ME, disposed of that rival before going three furlongs, opened a widening lead into the lane and was ridden out to the wire to be kept to task. POWER NEXT chased the leaders from off the rail, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. TIZ A CLASSIC was off slow, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. BOLD PLAN chased the leaders from between foes, steadied nearing the three-eighths marker, saved ground through the turn and failed to gain late. MR COUGAR GOLD was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. HOOCHEE MEMO was off a step slow, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. SUMMER COWBOY raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. U O ME was bumped at the break, duelled for the lead from the outside with the winner and weakened after going three furlongs. LA RAMONA was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
