LUCKY LAFLEUR sprinted clear soon after the start, increased his advantage through the back-stretch and was ridden out to the wire while appearing to labor late. WILD W B T was off a step slow, raced far wide through the first turn, chased the winner from the far outside throughout, could not reach that rival in the drive but was clearly second best. SACRED BLUFF lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, reached a contending position approaching the stretch but failed to gain in the drive. LOTTA PROMISE chased the leaders from the outside throughout and gradually gave way. T C'S LILCICSOCITY broke sharply to chase the leaders from off the rail and weakened after going three-quarters. FLASHY HALO raced off the pacesetters from the inside and weakened after going three furlongs. FRIJOLE BABY lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
