ZILVER was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and gamely held to the wire. DECLAN DOWNS pressed the pace of the winner throughout and grudgingly gave way to that rival through a prolonged drive. KUYA was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed late response. TW DASHBOARDLIGHTS was pinched back at the start, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. COLONEL COURTNEY raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out into the stretch and failed to rally. PADDY'S POT'O GOLD raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and did not menace. VEGAS FLYER broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. WATCH YOUR MONEY lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. COUGAR BOB was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and weakened.
