**Footnotes**

EZINMOTION raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch and wore down SHARPER KNIGHT through the final yards. SHARPER KNIGHT sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, remained in control through mid-stretch and yielded to the winner late. FREEDOMSLASTKNIGHT chased the leaders from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. SECRET ELEMENT chased the leaders early, checked nearing the quarter, angled inside and finished evenly late. RED SEA was void of early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and found his best stride late. SIMPERIO lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. TOM BOMBADIL chased the leaders from off the rail and weakened through the final furlong. RAINIER broke sharply to chased the leaders from the far outside and weakened after going a half. MR MAHAL was void of early foot, raced extremely wide through the turn and was not a factor. ISLAND RUN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. OH WILSON raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened.
