CHICKS DIG HIM was allowed to settle in stride early, moved outside through the turn, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and quickly drew off as a handy winner. l'lBEAMONKEYSUNCLE was away alertly to duel for the early advantage with BROULEE BEACH, disposed of that rival after going a half, opened a clear margin but was no match for the winner late. WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. GOLDLEDUE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, moved far wide through the turn and failed to menace. HAVIN A GOOD DAY was bumped at the start, showed no early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. BROULEE BEACH broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, weakened after going a half and was eased late.
