Footnotes

DECATUR ISLAND was never far back while racing along the inside, lacked racing room and was steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, moved between foes into the lane and drew off as a handy winner. THE PRINCE AND I broke in, lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished willingly to be clearly second best. MAZAMA pressed the pace from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. SMART AS JIM chased the leaders from the inside, dropped back nearing the three-eighths pole, moved outside into the stretch and finished with some late run. WAR TROPHY was pushed in at the start, showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with a belated rally. COUGAR GUY broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way after going a half. PETE'S BLACK GOLD was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. TRIESTE'D N TRUE was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after a half. HOLYSTACK was hustled along to show brief speed and weakened.
