SAINTLY I AIN'T raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, gained command into the lane, opened a clear lead and was fully extended to hold the closing SWORD BEACH off late. SWORD BEACH raced off the leaders from between foes, angled out into the lane and was gaining on the winner late. STORMIN' PETER was bumped at the start, chase the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. SHAKIN SHAMUS pressed the pace from the outside and gave way in the drive. MINGUN'S MARK showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. WEGOTLUCKY was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going a half. ALYAK'S SUPERSTAR chased the leaders from between foes and weakened after going three furlongs. WAR WAGER raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened. BROTHER WILLIE was off slow, raced off the rail into the land, went wrong nearing the eighth pole, was pulled up and vanned off.
