**Footnotes**

EZINMOTION was never far back, moved up from the outside to gain command into the lane and quickly drew off. COLONEL COURTNEY raced off the pacesetters from the inside, moved up for a striking position in mid-stretch but could not gain on the winner late. REMARKABLE TIMBER lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, gained a contending position nearing the furlong marker but also failed to gain late. NICK'S GOLD broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. COURTING SEATTLE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled inside nearing the eighth pole and found his best stride late. MIKALOUIE steadied nearing the five-eighths marker, moved up from the inside to duel for the early advantage and weakened after going a half. PERFECT KIVA lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. LASTING INFLUENCE raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened. IRISH HARMONY raced off the leaders from the far outside and weakened after the opening quarter. RED BALL EXPRESS was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going three furlongs.
