Footnotes

TRIBAL RYTHUM stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths marker, opened a clear margin into the lane and held sway to the wire. WILD W B T was off slow, raced wide through the turn, reached a striking position in mid-stretch but failed to gain on the winner late. MIKADO SILVER was bumped at the break, raced off the pacesetters from the outside, could not gain on the leaders in the drive and was all out to hold the show. MR. READY was never far back, raced wide through the turn, checked nearing the three-sixteenths pole, raced evenly thereafter and was unsaddled on the back-stretch and vanned off. DARYL showed no early speed, angled out in mid-stretch and found his best stride late. BLAZIN BROWN BOOT was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside for a half and weakened. FLASHY HALO lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. THOUGHTFUL GUY was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. MINISTER MAN was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from off the rail for a half, weakened and was eased late.
