Footnotes

AVANT GARDE broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths marker and held sway to the wire. SEATTLE DINER broke sharply to race closest to the winner throughout, angled out nearing the quarter and finished willingly. NOBALLSTWOSTRIKES raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn, reached a contending position into the lane and lacked the needed late response. SEETHATHARBOR chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. BRONCO WILLIE was never far back while racing along the inside and failed to gain on the leaders late. WARREN'S A LEGEND pressed the pace from between rivals and gradually gave way. WINDSHADOWS was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. DELAVEGA was void of early foot, raced off the rail into the stretch and was not a factor. GIG'S GAMBLE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. HAT TURN SIDEWAYS was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. JANS GOLD raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
