Footnotes

LANEY, unhurried early, was roused at the 1/4 pole to draw off and win as the rider pleased. LIL BONNIE ROSE, rank to place early, angled out for racing room on the turn, angled back in for the drive, split horses in late stretch and closed fast. SENSUAL GOLD was allowed to settle, rallied in the upper stretch and hung late. RED LINE DANCER, void of early, slipped through at the quarter pole and passed tired ones. MARY J was unhurried in the early stages, raced seven wide into the stretch while making a mild late bid. JAWVUS failed to menace. MUMA showed little. LOVERS' GOLD stalked the leaders along the inside and tired after a half mile. EASTER LU set the early pace, had a clear lead at the 5/16th pole and tired in late stretch. CELTIC BALLAD checked soon after the start and was never a threat. BALLYNESIAN was outrun. MISS GOLDED BAY broke sharply, pressed the pace for a half mile and stopped.
