Footnotes

DIAMOND PEAK pressed the pace from off the rail, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the three-sixteenths pole, vied with KAMILCHE MAGIC through the final furlong and held gamely over that rival to prevail. KAMILCHE MAGIC chased the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the turn, reached the winner in mid-stretch, vied with that rival and missed through a vigorous drive. DEAD EYE was off a step slow then allowed to settle, angled out into the stretch and was gaining on the leaders late. CAT MON BLUE was never far back while racing from the outside, angled inward into the lane, reached the leaders with a furlong to run but failed to gain late. STROLL FOR US set a pressured pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. RUN ATOM broke sharply then dropped of the leaders, moved outside through the turn and failed to threaten. SABE was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. RETURN IT showed brief speed, raced wide through the turn and weakened.
