Footnotes

BIRTHDAY TIME stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command inside the quarter, drifted inward nearing the eighth pole and steadily drew off. MISS MARLY B chased the leaders from off the rail, moved between foes to launch her rally nearing the quarter, angled outside the drifting winner in mid-stretch but failed to gain on that rival in the drive. PRE raced off the leaders from between foes, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, moved far outside through the turn and finished willingly in the drive. SWEET DEMAND hopped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the eighth pole and finished with her best stride late. CZARIS sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going a half. ANNIE'S SKY ANGEL was off slow, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. ZYDECKO DANCER showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and did not menace. LAUREN DEL LAGO broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after the opening quarter. The rider and trainer of MISS MARLY B lodged objections against BIRTHDAY TIME, concerning the drifting inward at the eighth pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
