SO GONE was away alertly then hustled along to set a pressured pace from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. CHACHING PETE chased the winner from the outside throughout and lacked the needed late response. CARRY ON JOHN was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. OLYMPIC LIGHTS raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. IMMIGRATION raced just off the leaders from between rivals and gradually gave way. WARRIOR JON lacked early speed, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled outside and failed to menace. BOSCO'S QWIK broke in the air, lagged early and did not reach contention. EMANCIPATED pressed the pace from the inside for three furlongs and weakened. MR. COLLABORATOR was off slow, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
