Footnotes

ENROLLMENT was off a step slow then allowed to settle, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the closing yards. PICKLED AGAIN raced off the pacesetters from the outside, moved up to a contending position approaching the stretch, gained a slight advantage late but could not resist the winner. HIP HOP CITY stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way late. OVER AND UNDER was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to engage the leaders with a furlong to run but lacked the needed late response. OUTSIDE SHOT chased the leaders from between foes and gave way through the final furlong. JIMMY THE CAT lacked early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and failed to menace. STICKY CANDY sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and weakened after going five furlongs. SON OF SASSY raced wide through both turns and was not a factor.
