Footnotes

RIVER OF LIGHTS broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the lane, drifted out nearing the furlong marker and held LITTLE COOKIE at bay to the wire. LITTLE COOKIE was bumped at the start, stalked the winner from the outside, moved up to offer a bid into the lane, steadied when that rival came out and did not gain thereafter. LIV TO DANCE bobbed at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. MAYAN CHICA was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. ZIA ZOOM ZOOM showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and did not reach contention. LOW EXPECTATIONS lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. BRAZILIAN RED raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. CHARM SCHOOL GIRL was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from between rivals and weakened after going a half.
